PLEASE PRAY FOR MISSIONE CHIESA, GIOELE SERIO (JOEL) MISSIONARY TO ALBANIA:

I am an Italian missionary from Rome. I was born in a Christian family and received Jesus when I was 11: God worked in my life incredibly, calling me to serve Him when I was 13.

Teenagers were difficult, as health dragged me down physically and mentally: but God never left me and when I was 20, He called to Bible College in Rome.

God opened just 1 year of that college, as He was preparing me to move in the UK: in 2019 in fact, I moved to a second Bible College in West Sussex, IBTI (International Bible Training Institute).

2019-2021 was a difficult season, student during COVID, but Jesus was with us, and I graduated and moved to London in 2021 to serve a local church in Bermondsey, Central London.

Assisting the pastor, evangelising, God did a great work in my personal life, stressing out the importance of prayer.

This last year I've been visiting Albania a few times: an Italian missionary in Kosovo invited me to see the work they do in the North of

Tirana back in March 2023: after many doors closed and God moving the path of my life in directions I could have never predicted, He confirmed with His word in November 2023 that He was then calling me to Albania as a missionary.

Now, I am in that process of moving out from the UK after 5 years and going to Albania as a full-time missionary.

There's a lot to do in Bathore, the Muslim area of Tirana: kids need Jesus, women need protection, and men need to be empowered and transformed.

May God bless us and keep us. Pray for pastor Genci Zeka and his wife Ilda, the pastor I will work with the church in Bathore, pray for Tirana and Albania, pray for the Balkans and God is moving. Grateful for Pastor Robin Asgher for praying and supporting me in past few months.
