One family with one daughter (6) Ciara came from Rochester, Kent. They attended for two days and spent a night with us. They really liked the church and teaching, and they would like to move into Cranford area. The mother expecting third child on Aug 12th. Please pray for them.

Two old Christian ladies and three mothers very kindly donated crisp, chocolates and squash for the kids. We are grateful to the Lord for their kind heartedness and generosity.

The highlight for me after the my talks with 25 teenagers and I offered copies of WALKING WITH GOD by JC Ryle, ULTIMATE QUESTION By J Blanchard and DAILY BREAD. 10 copies of WALKING WITH GOD and ULTIMATE QUESTIONS and 20 copies of DAILY BREAD were taken.
